National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health Period of 1998-2006

11 states

 California, Texas, Washington, Louisiana, Oregon, Florida, Michigan, New York, New Mexico, Iowa, Ohio

agencies involved

 CA DPR, public health, health services, department of health, CA EPA

Study continued

drift included

- spray, mist, <u>odor</u>
- volatilization
- migration of contaminated <u>dust</u>
- residue left by offsite movement
- wind speed & temperature inversion
- fumigations and helicopter applications

Inversion

- Central Coast Conditions
 - temperature and marine layer
 - cold air trapped below layer of warmer air
 - hot day / clear, calm, cool night
 - fog / overcast



DPR's air monitoring

Parlier 2009 (San Joaquin Valley)

- 12 months at Parlier schools
- Environmental Justice Action Plan
 - focus on environmental risk factors that impact children's health and communities adjacent to production ag
- motor vehicles and industrial emissions
- pesticides detected (low level)
 - chlorpyrifos and diazinon insecticides
 - MITC from fumigants

DPR's air monitoring continued

potential health risks of long-term exposure

new study began 2011

- Shafter (Kern County)
- Salinas (Monterey County)
- Ripon (San Joaquin County)
- monitor 24 hours a day
 - fumigants and organophosphates

Applicator's responsibility

- CCR 660 General Standards of Care
- aware of sensitive sites
- aware of neighborhood issues
- aware of weather conditions
- authority to make decision to stop

Future ...

with off-target movement of pesticides

- expanding definition of drift
- ag/urban interface
- better measuring methods
- new standards set with DPR's studies
- need for increased <u>awareness</u>
- need for open communication with
 - other growers
 - residents
 - field workers
