WHAT ARE FARMERS MARKETS?

Farmers markets are open-air markets where farmers sell their fresh products directly to customers. Each market is open for a few hours at the same time and place each week. You'll find delicious and nutritious fruits, vegetables, bread, eggs, fish, meat, and much more.

CAN I AFFORD FRESH FRUITS & VEGGIES?

Yes! Fresh fruits and vegetables can be affordable, especially when they're in season. Farmers market produce is often less expensive than at conventional grocery stores. Plus, the nutritional value is often greater, as our fruits and vegetables are harvested shortly before the farmers market, rather than sitting in a truck or on a shelf for a long time.

HOW DO I USE EBT AT THE FARMERS MARKET?

Just bring your EBT card to the information booth at your local Marin farmers market. We'll swipe your EBT card and give you tokens that you can use to shop for any of the EBT/CalFresh eligible foods.

WHY BUY LOCAL?

Buying local means supporting regional farmers and food purveyors, which strengthens the local economy, reduces the environmental impact of transporting food long distances, and allows customers to meet their farmers and to learn the story of where and how their food was grown.
