**Sun-Shade**: Full to part sun

Flower/Leaf Color/Season: Variety of colors,

many cultivars; Blooms in summer

Special Qualities: Native; tolerates deer, air pollution; attracts bees, butterflies, predatory

wasps, ladybird beetles, hoverflies.



**Common Name**: Buffalo Grass (UC Verde) **Botanical Name**: Buchloe dactyloides

Sun-Shade: Sun

Flower/Leaf Color/Season: None

**Special Qualities:** Turns brown in the winter. May need some water if the weather is very hot.



**Common Name**: Silver Carpet (Mini Gaziana) Botanical Name: Dymondia margartae

Sun-Shade: Sun

Flower/Leaf Color/Season: Small yellow flowers

bloom close to the mat in summer

Height/Width at Maturity: 6-12" tall x 3' wide

Special Qualities: Foliage is white on the top and light gray underneath which gives it a silver

appearance.



Common Name: Trailing Lantana

**Botanical Name**: Lantana montevidensis

Sun-Shade: Sun

Flower/Leaf Color/Season: Summer: flower color varies from white, yellow, pink or lavender Height/Width at Maturity: 12' tall, spreads to 6'

wide

**Special Qualities:** Attracts bees, butterflies, other insects that feed on nectar; deer dislike it.



**Common Name**: Dwarf Myrtle

**Botanical Name**: Myoporum parvifolium

'Prostratum' Sun-Shade: Sun

Flower/Leaf Color/Season: Small white flower

followed by purple berries

Height/Width at Maturity: 4" to 12" high



Common Name: Soapwort (Bouncing Bet,

Cowherb)

**Botanical Name**: Saponaria Ocymoides

Flower/Leaf Color/Season: Pink in late spring to

early summer; small sprays of flowers

Blooms for 4 weeks or more: Prune hard after

flowering to promote compact growth.

Height/Width at Maturity: 6"

Special Qualities: Prefers dryish soil with good



Common Name: Arbutus, Marina Botanical Name: Arbutus 'Marina' Deciduous or Evergreen: Evergreen

Sun-Shade: Full Sun

Bloom/Leaf Color/Season: Clusters of rosy pink

flowers in spring & fall

**Tree Shape**: Upright spreading, then drooping **Height at Maturity**: 20-40' tall x 20-40" wide

**Growth Rate**: Slow to Moderate

**Special Qualities:** Very similar to *A. unedo* but easier to grow as a single trunk and has larger

leaves.

**Special Qualities:** Edible flowers produce fruit

about 2" long.



Common Name: Desert Willow, Desert Catalpa

**Botanical Name**: *Chilopsis linearis* **Deciduous or Evergreen**: Deciduous

Sun-Shade: Full Sun

**Bloom/Leaf Color/Season**: White, pink or purple trumpet flowers spring to fall; long, narrow 2-5"

leaves

Tree Shape: Rounded, spreading

Height at Maturity: 15-30' tall x 10-20' wide

Growth Rate: Fast

Special Qualities: Wispy, open growth, drops

leaves early.



Botanical Name: Chitalpa taskentensis

'Pink Dawn'

**Deciduous or Evergreen**: Deciduous

Sun-Shade: Full Sun

**Bloom/Leaf Color/Season**: Clusters of pink, white or lavender, frilly trumpet shaped large flowers spring – fall; leaves 4-5" long, 1" wide

Tree Shape: Rounded, spreading

Height at Maturity: 20-30' tall x 20-30' wide

Growth Rate: Fast

**Special Qualities:** Rapid growth sometimes causes bark to split and weep, but usually

recovers. Avoid overwatering.



Common Name: Crape Myrtle

**Botanical Name**: Lagerstroemia indica **Deciduous or Evergreen**: Deciduous

Sun-Shade: Full Sun

**Bloom/Leaf Color/Season**: Showy pink, white, magenta, red, lavender flowers in summer

Tree Shape: Rounded

Height at Maturity: Up to 25' tall, Up to 25' wide

Growth Rate: Slow to Moderate

**Special Qualities:** Fall color and attractive bark provide added interest; grown as a single or multitrunk.

## **Drought Tolerant Perennials**



Common Name: Russian Sage

Botanical Name: Perovskia atriplicifolia

Sun-Shade: Full Sun

Flower/Leaf Color/Season: Lavender Blue in fall and summer, very finely cut gray-green leaves **Height/Width at Maturity**: 3'-4' tall x 2' wide

**Special Qualities:** Rarely damaged by deer, attracts bees, butterflies, hummingbirds; Can

become invasive.





Common Name: Orchid Rockrose

**Botanical Name**: Cistus

Sun-Shade: Sun

Flower/Leaf Color/Season: 3" purple flowers have red spot at base; Leaves are dark green

above and gray and hairy below.

Height/Width at Maturity: 4' tall x 4' wide

**Special Qualities:** Attracts butterflies; Often

planted in fire-hazard areas.



**Common Name**: Early Sunrise Tickseed **Botanical Name**: *Coreopsis grandiflora* 

Sun-Shade: Sun

**Flower/Leaf Color/Season**: Yellow to gold flowers with dark green narrow leaves from spring

through fall

Height/Width at Maturity: 15' tall x 18' wide

**Special Qualities:** Attracts beneficial insects;

Butterfly and other insect nectar.



Common Name: Little Rev (Baby Bliss Flax Lily)

**Botanical Name**: *Dianella revoluta* **Sun-Shade**: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Flower/Leaf Color/Season: Begins blooming in

spring to summer on nearly 3 foot tall

inflorescences that bear small deep violet blue flowers. Flowers rise above the tips of the blue

foliage.

Height/Width at Maturity: 3' tall x 2' wide

**Special Qualities:** Good for mass plantings, deer

tolerant, low maintenance.



Common Name: Autumn Sage

Botanical Name: Heatwave Salvia, Salvia

microphylla

**Sun-Shade**: Prefers sun, tolerates some shade

Flower/Leaf Color/Season: Lavenders,

magentas, oranges, pinks, purples, reds, yellows, whites and dramatic-to-delicate bicolors. Blooms

spring through autumn.

**Height/Width at Maturity**: Depends on variety; Range from 24" tall x 24" wide to 36" tall x 24" wide

**Special Qualities:** Attracts hummingbirds, bees, butterflies, deer resistant, fragrant; Some varieties are California natives.



**Common Name**: Flamenco Red Hot Poker Plant **Botanical Name**: *Kniphofia uvaria 'Flamenco'* 

Sun-Shade: Sun

**Flower/Leaf Color/Season**: Mixture of yellow, orange and fiery red flowers on 8" spikes; Appear in summer.

Height/Width at Maturity: 2' x 2'

Special Qualities: Attracts hummingbirds; Good

in containers; Long tap root.
