BENEFITS AND LIMITATIONS OF DRIP IRRIGATION

BENEFITS:

- 1. Uses water efficiently
- 2. Provides precise water control
- 3. Increases yields
- 4. Provides better control of saline water
- 5. Improves fertilization
- 6. Encourages fewer weeds in dry-summer climates
- 7. Saves time and labor
- 8. Reduces disease problems
- 9. Provides better water distribution on slopes
- 10. Promotes better soil structure
- 11. Conserves energy
- 12. Uses low-flow rates
- 13. Is more economical than permanent sprinkler systems

LIMITATIONS:

- 1. Initial costs are high
- 2. Can clog
- 3. May restrict root development
- 4. Rodents can eat the tubing
- 5. Isn't compatible with green manure and cover crops
- 6. Weeding can be difficult
- 7. Requires greater maintenance
- 8. Eliminates soothing hand watering
- 9. Doesn't cleanse the foliage
- 10. Doesn't create humidity
- 11. You can't see the system working
