

Announcing the 2019 State Fashion Revue Categories




- 1. **Traditional with \$40 limit** (unchanged from 2018); only open to 4-H Clothing and Textiles, aka Sewing project members.

- 3. **Retro/Historical Challenge** (formerly the Retro Challenge) garments inspired by styles from before the year 2000; only open to 4-H Clothing and Textiles, aka Sewing project members.
- 4. **Box Challenge** (our first NEW challenge!) For 2019 it is red/white/blue fabric and incorporates a list of items in your "box." Only open to 4-H Clothing and Textiles, aka Sewing project members.
- 5. **Make it Mine Challenge** altering a pattern or making your own pattern to achieve the fit and style you desire; open to all 4-H members

NOTE: The Upcycled category will NOT be offered at the 2019 State Fashion Revue, due to limited interest. As always, this category and others may be included in county fashion revues, but entries will not advance to the State Fashion Revue.
