The options include attending a Council meeting and giving a talk about your experience or giving a talk at your club's monthly meeting. It is also a courtesy to send a Thank You note for the scholarship funds to the Leader's Council.

*Please note: this will not cover the entire registration fee, only a percentage. The funds distributed will be no greater than the amount budgeted for the year. Funds for each member will not exceed 80% of the total registration costs.
