The purpose of this application is to determine equitable distribution of funds from the 4-H Leaders Council's approved budget for any of the Youth Summit Conferences. Each member who applies, and meets the criteria, will receive a share of those funds to cover a portion of the registration fees to attend one conference. *

Your family will be reimbursed only the scholarship amount awarded after you attend. Council will award money towards registration fees only. All other expenses are your responsibility such as gas, travel meals, etc.

If you are asked to leave the conference, or leave at your own will, council funds will not be awarded.

After the trip, the 4-H Council expects you (the 4-H member) to share your experience and information with other 4-H members. The options include attending a Council meeting and giving a talk about your experience or giving a talk at your club's monthly meeting. It is also a courtesy to send a Thank You note for the scholarship funds to the Leader's Council.

*Please note: this will not cover the entire registration fee, only a percentage. The funds distributed will be no greater than the amount budgeted for the year. Funds for each member will not exceed 80% of the total registration costs.
