To get started each 4-H adult volunteer leader will have to log into <u>https://campus.extension.org</u>.

Each adult volunteer leader in your home will have to use a separate email and passwords to be recorded on line for the volunteer leaders training courses.

## Here is a step by step 4-H online 2018-19 returning volunteer training instructions:

- go into 4-H & Youth
- At the bottom of the page click 3 (page 3)

- About 10-minute course
- Click on this tab. It will take you to the first video training.
- Complete this training then go onto the next training
- Abuse Risk Management for VolunteersSCORM package
- About 15-minute course
- Click on this tab. It will take you to the second video training.
- Once you have completed the both volunteer training vides you have completed the adult volunteer leaders training.
- You will be issued a certificate.
