### Happy 4-H Week: Marin Board of Supervisors Resolution

On the morning of October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2018, the **Marin County Board of Supervisors formally recognized National 4-H Week (Oct.7th - 13th) in Marin County**. Supervisor Dennis Rodoni, representing West Marin, sponsored the proclamation, acknowledging 4-H's role in supporting future leaders through experiential education in science, technology, arts, and agriculture. The Marin 4-H All-Star Team, along with other 4-H members, accepted the resolution on behalf of the county's youth members and adult volunteers.

#### **Types of Grants**

#### 1. JOANN 4-H Service Learning Project Grant

Projects must be from the <u>Qualifying Project List</u> and focus on a service learning project. Service Learning projects address a community issue and focus on creating and carrying out a plan to address the issue.

Number of awards: Up to two (2) \$450 awards

#### 2. JOANN 4-H Spark Project Grant

Projects must be from the <u>Qualifying Project List</u> that focuses on a person's spark! Sparks are what help youth see the potential within themselves.

#### Number of awards: Up to four (4) \$200 awards

#### 3. JOANN 4-H Innovative Project Grant

Projects must be from the <u>Qualifying Project List</u> and utilize the latest STEM innovations. Examples: 3-D printed fabrics, wearable technology, fabric design Number of awards: Up to three (3) \$500 awards
