Fashion Revue is an event for our 4-H members in the sewing project. They model their garments in front of judges and are interviewed. The top county winner(s) have the opportunity to attend the State 4-H Fashion Revue June 2, 2018 at UC Davis. Categories this year are Traditional, Upcycled, Consumer Science \$40 challenge, Stripe/Print/Plaid Challenge, and Knit Challenge. The Consumer Science \$40 challenge and Knit Challenge are opened to all 4-H members, no sewing requirement needed.

The Style Show portion of this event is where all of our 4-H members, both boys & girls, can model a purchased, borrowed, or home-sewn selection. They are also judged but not interviewed. We would like to see many of our 4-Hers enter this event.
