Jr. Livestock Committee Report

The JLC recently met and we would like share the proceedings of the last JLC meeting with 4-H families. Due to the outbreak of Newcastle Disease in Southern California and identification of a bird Northern California, California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) has recommended all poultry shows in California be canceled until further notice. CDFA will not allow a terminal show

because of the potential of spreading disease by fair goers and exhibitors. In order for families to best plan for the fair, the JLC made a decision to recommend to the fair management to cancel all poultry shows at the 2019 Lake County Fair. THERE WILL NOT BE A POULTRY SHOW OR POULTRY IN THE AUCTION at this year's fair, meaning no chickens or turkeys. The JLC will be working closely with the fair to offer alternative competitions for poultry enthusiasts such as a quiz bowl, educational display contest, presentation contest or mock showmanship. Any ideas would be welcome.

The Lake County Fair Foundation has generously agreed to purchase the remaining unsponsored pens. It is not too late to sponsor a pen, contact the fairgrounds if you are interested. A committee has been set to over see the purchase of the pens. There will be a ribbon cutting ceremony at this year's fair, stay tuned for further details. The foundation has also agreed to buy 500 new chairs so our buyers will have comfortable chairs at this year's auction.

Don't forget each exhibitor will be required to complete Youth Quality Assurance Training, YQCA. The cost is \$12 per person, the link is http://yqca.org/. This must be completed by August 12th, 2019.

All Star Award Received

Charlie Adams receives his All Star award from 4-H Council Vice President Keith Wentworth.

Charlie Adams of Lakeport, CA was recently recognized for his leadership and community engagement by earning the county's highest 4-H award as ALL Star Ambassador. Charlie has been a member of the Blue Heron 4-H club in Lakeport for 10 years. From the start, he was intensely engaged. Growing up with an animal loving family, he and his sister Robin became responsible for a backyard menagerie of ducks, chickens, chinchillas, rabbits, goats, guinea pigs, cats, and more. 
