UC ANR and UCCE office update

Event cancellations and office closure

All upcoming in-person events are cancelled, postponed, or transitioning to web-based formats. This will impact events through at least April 7, 2020.

UCCE events had previously been limited to certain numbers of attendees based on evolving CDC guidance. This step to delay or cancel in-person meetings for a few weeks is one part of widespread efforts to slow the spread of COVID19 and minimize the impact of COVID19 on public health.

Local UCCE offices are going to be closed to the public and employees will be working remotely beginning March 17 and continuing through at least April 7, 2020.

To protect ourselves and other employees, we have been ordered to practice social distancing (maintaining physical space between ourselves and others). The most effective way to distance ourselves is to avoid congregating even in small numbers in our offices.

As such, we have been asked to work remotely until at least April 7. Office closures will begin this process as of March 17, 2020. Some critical county staff may remain if needed. In general, we suggest you **contact your local farm advisor by email for the quickest response.**
