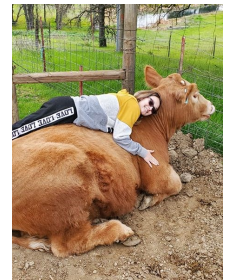
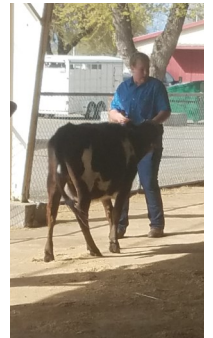

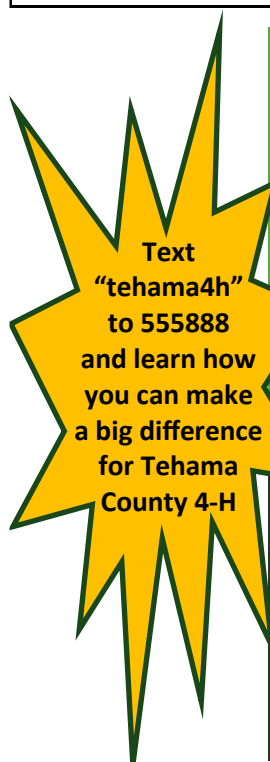
# Countywide Projects
