Dear San Benito County 4-H Community,

Giving Tuesday is just around the corner. Our goal is to raise \$10,000 to start an endowment to support our 4-H Representative position into the future. We can get to \$10,000 by raising only \$4,000 on Giving Tuesday.

Here's how it works. On Giving Tuesday, which is December 1, the 4-H Foundation will match the first \$25,000 in gifts dollar for dollar. However, large donations (\$1,000 to \$4,000) are our current target. We are also reaching out to the 4-H Council to consider making a large donation to help reach our \$4,000 goal. Your gift will help us expand and build our 4-H program today and help sustain the program for years to come.


