

Monterey County 4-H Interview Event

April 17th & 18th, 2021 VIRTUALLY

Our new Interview Event is an activity that gives 4-H members an opportunity to practice the real-life skills needed to apply for a job. For the 2021 year, it is modeled after the state 4-H Interview Contest. Participants prepare a resumé and cover letter for a job they choose from the job descriptions listed below. Evaluators score the participants performance during a mock interview (held via Zoom) and offer constructive feedback. Participants will learn valuable skills!



- **Learn how to get a job!**
- **Increase your public speaking skills!**
- **Write your resume!**
- **Discover the power of a *Cover Letter***
- **Plan for your summer income!**

4-H Interview Event participants must do the following:

1. Choose a job: Choose from one of the three jobs listed below in your age category.
2. Develop a resumé: Include real-life experiences (education, work, activities, etc.) that demonstrate your qualifications for the job selected.
3. Write a cover letter: Your cover letter should explain why you should be considered for the job selected.
4. The day of - Dress appropriately: Appropriate dress includes 4-H uniform or attire appropriate for a job interview as outlined in the California State 4-H Interview Contest Manual.

>> Participants must upload completed resume and cover letter files upon registration by March 29, 2021 by 5pm.
