UC Cooperative Extension Almond Rootstock Field Day

When: June 23, 2021 9:00 a.m.

Where: 10061 Vineyard Avenue, between Patterson & Westley

What: Walk through a 10th leaf almond orchard featuring Nonpareil on 16 rootstocks grown under “typical” Westside North San Joaquin Valley farming conditions: high pH, clay-loam soil irrigated with water moderately high in chloride. We will discuss tree performance including salt tolerance, leaf nutrient differences, anchorage, tree size, and yield. Rootstocks include: Atlas, BB106, Brights 5, Empyrean 1, FxA, GF 677, Hansen, Krymsk 86, Lovell, Nemaguard, Rootpac R and Viking.

We will also have a demonstration on how to use a pressure chamber (a.k.a. pressure bomb) to monitor tree water stress, a great tool for irrigation scheduling.



Almond Variety Trial Field Day

Sponsored by the University of California Cooperative Extension and
the Almond Board of California

When: June 30, 2021 9:00-10:30 a.m.

Where: 5990 Pirrone Road, Salida

What: View 30 almond varieties and experimental selections growing side by side in this 8th leaf commercial orchard. This is one of three regional trials where we collect data on bloom time, disease and insect susceptibility, hull split, yield, kernel quality and more. The trial includes 15 experimental selections, including 12 self-fertile varieties. Commercial varieties include Bennett-Hickman, Booth, Capitola, Durango, Eddie, Folsom, Jenette, Kester, Sterling, Supareil, Sweetheart, Winters, and the new Yorizane. UC, USDA and commercial breeders and nurseries will be present to answer questions.
