

Are you interested in conducting a prescribed burn on your ranch?

Getting a burn plan is the first step! The Central Coast Prescribed Burn Association (CCPBA) has funding, through a CAL FIRE grant, to write 5 prescribed burn plans. Here are the details:

- These 5 burn plans are designated for private ranchers in San Benito, Monterey, and Santa Cruz counties
- There is no cost to landowner for the burn plan
- Burns plans can be written for 10 to 1,000-acre burns units
- No CEQA or other environmental compliance is required to get the burn plans
- The CCPBA will work with the landowner to secure additional funds to implement the burn itself
