To apply for this position, applicants must complete a 2020-2021 4-H Record Book on or before the Record Book due date of June 11, 2021, complete the attached application, review and sign the All-Star County Ambassador Contract, get a letter of recommendation from your Community Leader, prepare an All-Star County Ambassador interview presentation and provide your supporting documents for the day of the interview.

All completed documents must be scanned and emailed into the 4-H Office by 5pm on Friday, May 27, 2022 to ilgarcia@ucanr.edu. Interviews will be held Wednesday, June 1, 2022 (time to be announced). Interviews will be held via Zoom.

Imperial County 4-H All-Star County Ambassador Information

County Ambassador is the highest attainable County 4-H rank. It is awarded each year to a selected number of older 4-H members who have made or would like to make a significant contribution to the 4-H Youth Program in our county. These are members who recognize the opportunity and responsibility of being selected as All Stars and are receptive to new challenges and new ideas.

Requirements

- 1. Member must be at least 15 years of age by June 1st of current year.
- 2. Must be a member in good standing within their own 4-H Club.
- 3. Must have been a 4-H Member for at least 2 years prior to submitting an application.
- 4. Must have been a club officer for at least one year within their 4-H club.

Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Each All-Star County Ambassador team will plan and carry out a specific program (i.e., improve on a current county activity, develop or expand a specific county activity).
- 2. All-Star County Ambassadors will be actively involved in a leadership role at County events.
- 3. All-Star County Ambassadors will attend 4-H Council meetings and present a monthly report that updates Council on activities and events.
- 4. All-Star County Ambassadors are encouraged to attend Regional 4-H Leaders' Council meetings
- 5. All-Star County Ambassadors and their parents will attend an orientation meeting that outlines duties and responsibilities.

Awards

- 1. All-Star County Ambassadors will receive an All-Star pin, emblem, jacket, and shirt provided by the Imperial County Leaders Council.
- 2. Registration Expense-paid trip to the All-Star Conference/State 4-H Conference at the University of California Davis by the Imperial County 4-H Council. (Does not include transportation)

All-Star County Ambassador Presentation Plan

As part of the interview process, applicants will be required to give a 3-5 minute presentation on the topic listed below. Presentation order will be randomly selected. Visual aids (props) and digital slides may be used (Zoom Screen Share option available). Evaluation of presentations will be based on the basic 4-H Presentation Guidelines, including: presentation of subject to judges, knowledge of subject, creativity, professional demeanor, voice, eye contact and answering questions. Read the following topic and develop a four to five minute presentation. Presentations should not exceed five minutes in length.

Presentation Topic:

Provide a concept for a new county-wide project that incorporates one of the 4-H mission mandates (Science/SET, Healthy Living, Citizenship and Thrive). Address the importance of this mission mandate in Imperial County 4-H, the types of opportunities in our county currently, and your idea for new opportunities related to the specific mission mandate. Explain how you would promote engagement with all clubs, and what the overall goal would be, including your long-term vision. Information on mandates can be found here: http://4h.ucanr.edu/Projects/

Remember, this is a *presentation*, not an essay. Note cards are allowed, and creativity is encouraged!
