2.	Identify 15 external parts of a goat from a diagram or live goat		
3.	Explain how to determine the minimum age of a goat based on the development of teeth		
4.	Explain and demonstrate how to tattoo a goat. Explain what the tattoos on the left and right ear or tail webs of a registered goat represent		
5.	Explain breed requirements and the process for registering a goat with its national or international breed associations.		
6.	Obtain contact info for breed associations and identify at least tow types of information you can obtain from that contact information for two breeders of meat goats.		
7.	Explain selecting a goat for purchase, such as correctness of breed for conformation, color, rate of growth, length, and other factors important for your specific project goats		
8.	Compare and contrast the conformation of three goats of the same type.		
9.	Identify what diseases or conditions may be prevent by immunizations or other medicines. Implement an immunization schedule for your project and determine drug withdrawal periods of of your meat goat project.		
10.	Explain the symptoms and treatments for four common goat illnesses.		
11.	State the breeding age and weight requirements of your meat goat. Tell what the breeding season is for your goat and the length of gestation.		
12.	Describe how and why you sanitize your goats equipment and housing facilities.		
13.	Describe the proper fitting for your meat goat and the tools needed when preparing for a show. Identify supplies to take to a show.		
14.	Demonstrate competency in showmanship of your goat. How to properly handle from setting up to maneuvering in the show ring in front of a judge.
