Skills Gained/Practiced:

- Livestock Showmanship - Sportsmanship and actual showmanship techniques.
- Organization - Show preparation and show participation.
- Communication - Comprehension of show rules and schedule. Verbal and nonverbal communication with livestock judges.
- Confidence - Every minute spent in the ring builds confidence for the next time the youth enters the ring.

Event Rules:

1. **Please follow Exhibitor/Livestock 'Check-in' on the Event Schedule above. (Page 1)**
2. Primary 4-H members, ages 5-8, may show in the Primary Showmanship class only (Nigerian Dwarf Goat). Ages are as of December 31, 2023.
3. All livestock entered must be currently owned and cared for by the exhibitor under the direct supervision of a certified 4-H leader.
4. **Breeding entries may NOT be entered in prospect classes or vice versa.**
5. All animals brought to the show must be entered in a conformation or prospect class, except Nigerian Dwarf Goats entered in Primary Showmanship.
6. **Do not bring animals that have been or may be sick** - show management reserves the right to remove unacceptable animals
7. **All animals will be health checked during weigh-in.**
8. All exhibitors must be supervised by an instructor/leader or designated adult.
9. An exhibitor must show (handle) his/her own animal. If more than one animal is entered in conformation or prospect class, another current 4-H member, 9 years old and up, may assist by showing the extra animal.
10. **Long pants and appropriate footwear (closed-toes shoes or boots) are required in all livestock classes. Sleeveless shirts and bare midriffs are not allowed.** Exhibitors may wear their 4-H uniform but it is not required for participation. Uniforms are not a criterion in judging.
11. Exhibitors may not serve as clerks/youth co-judges for any division they have entered.
12. The exhibitor is responsible for meeting check-in and judging times. Exhibitors and livestock must be ready when classes are called. **Late exhibits will not be judged.**
13. Each exhibitor is guaranteed one pen for market animals and one pen for breeding animals. Additional pen space may be available for breeding animals.
14. Bedding will not be provided.
15. No tack pens will be available.
16. **All pens MUST be cleaned (including animal waste and bedding) by the exhibitor before a "Get Outta Here" card is issued and the animal(s) may be released.** A designated waste disposal area will be provided. **Be sure to BRING a shovel, rake, and broom to clean your pens and walkways.** \$25 fee for stalls left unclean.
17. The 4-H staff and/or show management will not be responsible for unattended or unclaimed animals

Event Rules specific to Market Animals:

1. **All prospect animals entered are LIMITED to Tehama County 4-H members ONLY and should be intended for the exclusive purpose of exhibition at the 2024 Tehama District Fair.**
2. Prospect classes will be divided by weight at the discretion of show management.

DIVISION A: Dairy Cattle

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship.
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation classes.
3. All breeds judged together.

Class 1: Showmanship, 9 - 10 years old
Class 3: Showmanship, 14 years old and up
Class 5: Conformation, Jr. and Sr. Yearlings

Class 2: Showmanship, 11 - 13 years old
Class 4: Conformation, Jr. and Sr. Calves
Class 6: Conformation, Cows 2 years and older

DIVISION B: Dairy Goat

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship.
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation classes.
3. All breeds judged together.
4. **4-H PRIMARY MEMBERS (5-8 years old) are permitted in Class 1 ONLY;** no judging, participation ribbons only

Class 1: Showmanship, **4-H Primary Members only;** Nigerian Dwarf Goat

Class 2: Showmanship, 9 - 10 years old

Class 3: Showmanship, 11 - 13 years old

Class 4: Showmanship, 14 years old and up

Class 7: Conformation, Non-milking Senior Doe, over 6 months old

Class 8: Conformation, Milking Doe 1 & 2 years old

Class 9: Conformation, Milking Doe 3 years old

Class 10: Conformation, Milking Doe 4 years and older

Class 11: Conformation, Bucks (0 months to not yet 2 years)

DIVISION C: Beef

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship.
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation/Prospect classes.
3. **Prospect Classes are limited to Tehama County 4-H Exhibitors Only**
4. All breeds judged together.
5. Blue ribbons from each weight break of Class 8 advance to the final round of Class 8

Class 1: Showmanship, 9 - 10 years old

Class 2: Showmanship, 11 - 13 years old

Class 3: Showmanship, 14 years old and up

Class 4: Conformation; Junior Heifer Calf; 0 to 4 months old

Class 5: Conformation; Senior Heifer Calf; 5 to 8 months old

Class 6: Conformation; Yearling Heifer; over 9 months old

Class 7: Cow/Calf Pair - calf must be prodigy of Cow

Class 8: Prospect Steer; broken by weight
Tehama County 4-H Members only

DIVISION D: Sheep

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship.
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation/Prospect classes.
3. **Prospect Classes are limited to Tehama County 4-H Exhibitors Only**
4. All breeds judged together.
5. Blue ribbons from each weight break of Class 9 advance to the final round of Class 9.

Class 4: Conformation, Ewe lambs 6 months and under
Class 6: Conformation, Yearling Ewes (over 1 year and not yet 2)

Class 7: Conformation, Ewes 2 years and older

Class 8: Conformation, Ram lambs (0 months to not yet 2 years)

Class 9: Prospect Lamb; broken by weight

DIVISION E: Swine

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship.
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation/Prospect classes.
3. **Prospect Classes are limited to Tehama County 4-H Exhibitors Only**
4. All breeds judged together.
5. Young swine **MUST** be weaned
6. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring their own fighting boards.
7. Blue ribbons from each weight break of Class 8 advance to the final round of Class 8.

4. All breeds judged together.
5. Blue ribbons from each weight break of Class 9 advance to the final round of Class 9.
